**Gate Access Passes (GAP's):** The email account to request gate access passes (GAPs) is [bwigap20@gmail.com](mailto:bwigap20@gmail.com). The deadline for requests is **36 hours** prior to the first flight of the day. Please enter GAP Request(s) in the subject line and the date(s) and Airline Hub(s) you are requesting GAP's for in the body of the email. **Unless you are meeting the first flight of the day, please let us know which flight you will be meeting.** This helps us with volunteers being available for you to pick up your gate pass and drop off your parking ticket for validation. If your plans change and you will not be at the airport, please advise through [bwigap20@gmail.com](mailto:bwigap20@gmail.com) account up to and including the day of the flight so we do not have a volunteer waiting for you instead of greeting the Veterans.. GAP requests received after the 36-hour cut off will not be honored.

If anyone encounters problems, let me (Jennifer) know - (443)-995-2221 and we can try and sort it out so you don't have to pay.

Please note that we cannot request gate passes if **Allegiant** or **Breeze Airlines** are the only flights coming in that day.

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The requested format for submitting is:

First name, Middle initial, Last name, date of birth, (mm/dd/yy format) and gender.  
Please submit it in this format:

**John D. Smith, 03/16/99, male**

Requests with multiple names should be sorted by last name. When you are submitting a request where several people have the same last name, please also sort it by first name. For example:

**Amy M. Smith, 04/21/99, female**

**John D. Smith, 03/16/99, male**

Please check that your information is correct before submitting as those requests received that are not in the requested format will be returned with a request to reformat.

If you are military, please note on your request so we can assign you to the correct listing. If you do not receive a response to your request within 24 hours, please email [jjabner@verizon.net](mailto:jjabner@verizon.net) so she can respond. **Important:** if your plans change and you will not be at the airport, please advise through the [bwigap20@gmail.com](mailto:bwigap20@gmail.com) account up to and including the day of the flight.

Please park in the hourly garage and bring in your parking ticket for validation at door #10 along with a government issued picture ID. Please note face coverings are optional at BWI airport. The parking validation deadline is 60 minutes before the flight arrival time. Everyone, babes in arms included, needs a GAP. A picture ID is **not required** for those under the age of 18 and children under 12 do not have to remove their shoes. Also, volunteers **75 and older** can leave their shoes and a light jacket on. If the shoes set off the alarm, you will be asked to take them off and go through the screening again.

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When volunteers enter the hourly garage, they will get the new type of ticket with a **QR code** on it. We now have a scanner in the Pathfinder office we can use to scan the QR code on the ticket and it will confirm that it has been validated. So your original parking ticket will be returned to you and when you exit the garage you can use any lane - credit card and prepaid lanes included - and scan on the machine at the exit lane. You should do this even if you go to a cash lane. Just scan, you will keep the ticket, and the barrier bar will rise to let you out.

Pick up point for all **GAPs** and drop off of **parking passes** will be **door #10** on the upper level. This gives us more space to congregate. This will also enable us to get parking passes validated more quickly. The pick-up point for validated parking passes will be at the same location. If you do not find a **yellow shirt** at this location, please check with the **D Information Desk** located nearby the **United** check-in desk.

**Lone Eagle:** A **Lone Eagle** is a Veteran whose application has been in our national office for one year or more, yet they do not live close to one of our existing hub cities. Our definition of "close" is within a 120-mile radius of the airport used by the closest hub. When we discover a veteran who qualifies for this program, we will make every effort to fly them from a large commercial airport near their home. **Honor Flight Network** is responsible for arranging transportation for all Lone Eagle Veterans.

There are **48 Veterans** scheduled throughout the day on several **airlines**.

**The Lone Eagle Veterans** will be flying into BWI airport at different times of the day. They will be picked up by a Hilton bus and taken to the Airport Hilton where they will check -in, get reception bag(s), head to their rooms to freshen up and come back down to the lobby area to meet other Veterans arriving. Later that afternoon they will be served dinner. They will retire for the night and prepare for pick-up by a bus(s) early next morning for the trip down to their Memorials.

If you would like to meet and greet some of them, no *GAP* required, we suggest going straight to the hotel usually late morning/early afternoon and wander around looking for these Veterans. Conversations are encouraged.
